



Jack Stack

Supply List:

1 Large Pumpkin, 1 Medium Size Pumpkin, 1 Small Pumpkin, Pumpkin Carving Saws, Black Marker, Small Battery Powered Lights, Pumpkin Scoop or Spoon, Templates & Tape (optional), Twigs, and Kids Clothing



Step 1 Pick a Pumpkin

You will need three pumpkins for this project. A large pumpkin for the base, a medium size pumpkin for the middle, and a small pumpkin for the head.

Step 2 Bottom & Center of the Stack

Use a black marker to draw a circle around the tops of the large and medium pumpkins (be sure to make the top of the large pumpkin slightly smaller than the diameter of the medium pumpkin). Carve out the tops of both pumpkins then scrape the insides clean of all seeds and strings.



Step 3 Top of the Stack

Draw a circle on the side of the small pumpkin, towards its base. Carve out the circle and scrape the inside clean of all seeds and strings.

Step 4 Stack the Jacks

Stack the pumpkins on top of each other, from the largest to the smallest. Draw two small circles on the bottom and middle pumpkins (these will be the “buttons”). Draw a face on the top pumpkin or use a template.



Step 5 Carve and Light

Use a pumpkin carving saw to carve the button holes and face. Place battery powered lights in all three pumpkins and restack.

Use the pumpkin carving saw to carve tiny holes in either side of the middle pumpkin. Insert twigs to create the arms.
